This river is the deepest in the world, and it empties into the Atlantic Ocean on Africa's western coast. What is the name of this river in central Africa, second-longest after the Nile?

One of the African Great Lakes, this body of water is the second-largest and second-deepest lake in the world after Lake Baikal in Russia. Over 250 types of brightly colored fish called cichlids live here. What lake is this, shared between four countries?

Bordered by Cameroon and Chad, this country is the most populous in Africa. Its largest city is Lagos, and people who live in this country speak many different languages like Yoruba, Igbo, and Hausa. What country is this?

This grassland is known for being home to the “Great Migration,” when two million wildebeest travel to look for food each spring. It is found in Tanzania, where it’s a national park. What’s the name of this ecosystem, also home to a tribe of cattle herders called the Maasai?

Much of this country is covered by the Kalahari Desert, which extends into neighboring Namibia and South Africa. In the northern part of this country you can find the Okavango Delta, wetlands that are home to leopards, elephants, and giraffes. What country is this?
