**B** - This lake is located in Siberia and is known to be the deepest lake in the world. Name this lake.

**C** - This river has carved many spectacular canyons, including the Grand Canyon, along its course to its mouth at the Gulf of California. What's this river?

**D** - This lake is so salty that it is home to no life forms except bacteria. What is the name of this lake, the lowest point on land below sea level?

**E** - Which tall metal landmark in Paris was built in 1889 for the World's Fair hosted there?

**F** - These islands lie south of Cape Horn, and are claimed by the UK. What islands are these?

**G** - What reef system, the largest in the world, sits off Australia's northeastern coast?

**H** - This bay, named after a famous English explorer, borders the Canadian provinces of Manitoba, Ontario, and Quebec. Name this bay.

**I** - This waterfall is the largest in the world, located along the Brazil-Argentina border. What is its name?

**J** - The cities of Kyoto and Sapporo can be found in what country off the coast of mainland Asia?

**K** - This desert covers almost three-quarters of Turkmenistan, and its name translates to "black sand." What desert is this?

**L** - This Baltic country borders Estonia to the north and Lithuania to the south. What country is this?

**M** - What island, Africa's largest, is home to unique flora and fauna, including several species of lemurs?

**N** - This African river's two main tributaries, the Blue and the White, meet near Khartoum, Sudan, to form the main stream of this river. What river is this?

**O** - This inland delta in Botswana is an area of wetland that provides habitat for elephants, giraffes, and leopards. What's the name of this delta?

**P** - The deepest point in this ocean is Challenger Deep, almost seven miles underwater. What ocean is this, surrounding islands like Tonga and Samoa?

**Q** - This Arabic-speaking nation is almost completely surrounded by water, but is home to no permanent lakes or rivers. Which country is this?

**R** - This body of water is an estuary, where a river meets the ocean, and is located between Uruguay and Argentina. Its name means "river of silver" in Spanish. What is the name of this estuary?

**S** - The largest lake in the United States by volume, this lake borders three states and one Canadian province. Which of the Great Lakes is this?

**T** - This country borders the Black and Caspian Seas. What country is this, with cities like Ankara and Izmir?

**U** - The Aleutian Islands stretch about 1,200 miles and separate the Bering Sea from the Pacific Ocean. What country do they belong to?

**V** - Often referred to as "Mother Russia," this longest river in Europe empties into the Caspian Sea. What river is this?

**W** - This sea borders the Antarctic Peninsula and is located in the southernmost part of the Atlantic Ocean. What's the name of this sea?
