7. Located on the Yucatan Peninsula, this country borders Mexico and Belize. The ancient Maya city of Tikal is found in this country, and is visited by tourists from around the world. What country is this, whose currency, the quetzal, is named for a colorful bird?

8. This country, once called Abyssinia, can be found on the Horn of Africa. The mountains and highlands covering this country were home to some of the oldest modern humans. What country is this, whose currency is the birr?
