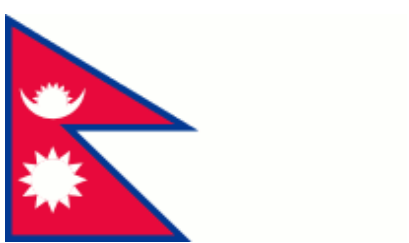
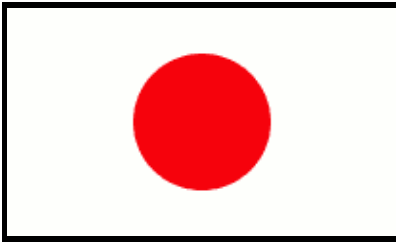


Flags

12. This flag is unique because it's the only double pennant used as a country's flag. Mt. Everest sits on this country's border with China, and its capital is Kathmandu. What country is this?
13. Created by freed slaves from the U.S., this country's flag is based on the Star-Spangled Banner. What's the name of this country in western Africa, covered in swamps, rainforest, and grassland?
14. This country's flag was an inspiration for the Red Cross, a worldwide organization based in Geneva, a city in this country. Name this country, crossed by the Alps and bordered to the south by Italy.
15. Found in the Indian Ocean off the coast of eastern Africa, this island country has a bright and colorful flag. This country has lots of coral reefs and beaches, and is known for its giant Aldabra tortoises. What country is this?
