4. Towering over the plains of the Serengeti, this mountain is the tallest in Africa. It was once an active volcano, but it's now dormant and covered in glaciers. What is the name of this mountain in Tanzania?
5. Rivers to the east of this mountain range drain into the Atlantic Ocean and on the west they drain into the Pacific. These mountains run through Canada and US states like Utah and Montana. What mountain range is this, naming a national park in Colorado?
6. These mountains run through seven countries. Once home to the Inca civilization, they include ancient cities like Cusco and Machu Picchu, and modern ones like Lima and La Paz. What is the name of this very long mountain range?
7. A peninsula in southern Europe takes its name from these mountains. They run from east to west, from the Black Sea across Bulgaria and Serbia. What mountains are these, passing by Bulgaria's capital of Sofia?

8. Once as tall as the Rocky Mountains, this range has been worn down over millions of years. Starting up in Canada, these mountains stretch down into Georgia and Alabama. What's the name of these mountains in eastern North America?

9. This mountain range sits between the Black and Caspian Seas and includes Mt. Elbrus, the highest mountain in Europe. Three capital cities - Baku, Yerevan, and Tbilisi - are found in these mountains. What mountain range is this?

10. People living among these mountains speak many languages, like Spanish, French, Basque, and Catalan. The tiny country of Andorra sits in the middle of these mountains. What's the name of this range, separating the Iberian Peninsula from the rest of Europe?

11. This volcano is part of the Cascades, a mountain range that runs through the Pacific Northwest. In 1980, this volcano erupted and the top of the mountain was blown into a crater. What's the name of this explosive volcano in Washington?

12. This mountain range is often used to mark the border of Europe and Asia. These mountains are some of the oldest in the world, and they're rich in coal, metals, and precious stones. What's the name of this Russian mountain range?
