1. This Montana national park is home to animals like grizzly bears, moose, and bison. The first national park in the U.S., this area also contains lots of geothermal features like geysers, paint pots, and hot springs. What is the name of this park, home to Old Faithful?
2. Found in Colorado, this national park is home to hundreds of cliff dwellings called pueblos. Built by ancient Native Americans, these sites are some of the best-preserved in the United States. What is the name of this park, whose name is Spanish for “green table”?
3. This national park is one of extremes! Sitting on the California-Nevada border, it contains the hottest, driest, and lowest points in North America, and it’s the largest national park in the country. What is the name of this park, home to salt flats, sand dunes, and canyons?
4. This popular national park in Colorado is located near the tourist town of Estes Park. Named for the massive mountain range it spans, this park includes forests, lakes, and tundra that can be seen from its main route, Trail Ridge Road. What national park is this?
5. For over 12,000 years, the land around this park has been inhabited by the local Blackfoot and Salish tribes. Located along the border between Montana and Canada, it’s part of the world’s first international peace park. What national park is this?
6. This national park is the only one in Oregon, and it’s the fifth-oldest in the country. The deep, clear lake at the park’s center was formed when an ancient volcano erupted and collapsed. What’s the name of this western national park?
7. Close to 4,000 people visit this national park each day during peak season, but much of this park is located underground. Almost 400 miles of caves have been mapped in this park, making it the longest cave system in the world. What is the name of this national park in Kentucky?

8. Towering rock formations called hoodoos are some of the most popular sights in this national park. Found near Zion National Park, what is the name of this famously red-colored national park in southern Utah?
  
9. This national park is located in northern Minnesota, close to the town of International Falls. It's named for French-Canadian fur-traders who traveled through its waters, and is popular with fishermen, kayakers, and canoeists. What national park is this?
  
10. You can see temperate rainforest, meadows of wildflowers, and miles of rugged coastline in this Washington national park. It can be found on a peninsula of the same name that borders Puget Sound. What national park is this?
  
11. Active volcanoes like Kilauea and Mauna Loa form the basis of this national park. Found on Hawaii's "Big Island," this national park has had to close to the public several times because of volcanic eruptions. What's the name of this island park?
  
12. This national park consists of sawgrass marshes and mangrove forests, which are home to panthers, alligators, and manatees. What's the name of this swampy park in southern Florida?
