3. This bay, named after a famous English explorer, borders the Canadian provinces of Manitoba, Ontario, and Quebec. Churchill, a town known as the "Polar Bear Capital of the World," is on the western shore of this bay. What bay is this?
4. After passing through many countries in Europe, the Danube River feeds this sea. Crimea, a peninsula on this sea, is claimed by both Ukraine and Russia. What's the name of this sea, running along the north of Turkey?
5. Lots of rivers feed this bay, including the Ganges, the Brahmaputra, and the Irrawaddy. Chennai and Chittagong are two ports on this bay's shores. What bay is this, bordering Sri Lanka and Myanmar?
6. Sao Tome and Principe is surrounded by this gulf of the Atlantic Ocean. The Equator and the Prime Meridian meet in this gulf, south of Ghana. What gulf is this, found in western Africa?
7. This bay experiences higher tides than anywhere else on the planet - about 50 feet between high and low tide. What's the name of this bay of the Atlantic Ocean, bordered by Canada's provinces of New Brunswick and Nova Scotia?

8. This Asian country consists of thousands of islands, big and small. These islands are surrounded by seas like the Java, Banda, and Celebes. What's the name of this country, whose capital is Jakarta?

9. The colorful name of this sea comes from the bacteria blooms it sometimes experiences. It is connected to the Mediterranean Sea through the Suez Canal. What sea is this, bordered by Eritrea and Saudi Arabia?

10. In prehistoric times, this sea was an area of low plains home to early humans. This sea is rich in fish and underwater oil, and its beaches are popular among tourists. What sea is this, crossed by the Vikings hundreds of years ago?

11. Pearls, fish, oil, and natural gas are products of this gulf that are sold around the world. This gulf is separated from the Indian Ocean by the Strait of Hormuz. What gulf is this, bordered by Kuwait and Bahrain?

12. Tunis, Beirut, and Genoa are all cities on this sea's coast. Containing many smaller seas like the Ionian and Adriatic, what's the name of this sea that joins the Atlantic Ocean at the Strait of Gibraltar?

13. Sometimes considered a lake, this inland "sea" is the biggest in the world. This sea is rich in oil and caviar, or fish eggs. What's the name of this sea, lying just to the west of the Caucasus Mountains?
